## Liberty Township Board of Trustees

### Special Meeting

On February 26, 2018 the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of Liberty Township, Union County, Ohio convened for a special meeting at 7:00 pm in the LIBERTY TOWNSHIP MEETING ROOM. The purpose of the meeting is to continue a hearing regarding a fence dispute between two property owners.

Chairperson Karen Johnson called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The following members and guest were present:

#### **BUSINESS**

The purpose of the meeting is to hopefully render a decision regarding the fence dispute between Mullaney Ltd. and Dan Hutchins. Assistant Prosecutor Rick Rodger was present as was court reporter Tammy Kleiber. Jerry McClary moved that the board convene in executive session to go over transcripts of previous hearings and evidence. Jack McCoy seconded the motion and a vote was taken. Karen Johnson-aye, Jack McCoy-aye, Jerry McClary-aye. The board asked Jeff Rea and Rick Rodger to join them in discussion. Executive session began at 7:05 pm and exited at 8:10 pm. Following the session Fiscal Officer Jeff Rea read the decision of the Trustees to the audience. Based on physical evidence and testimony the Trustees decided there was value to both parties and follows the equal shares rule and assigned 75 percent of the cost to Mr. Hutchins and 25 percent to Mullaney Ltd. as outlined in their formal decision.
